Bespoke Funeral Services

A Bespoke funeral is created and priced according to the wishes of our client, unlike the set packages in the Lower Cost Funeral Options brochure. The cost of a Bespoke Funeral is made up of three elements; our charges for the services and vehicles which we provide, the coffin chosen, and the charges made by the various third parties who provide their services for the funeral.

Our Core Charges include:

- Our Full Professional Services, including 24 hour telephone service.
- Transfer of deceased into our care from hospitals in Nottingham, Derby, Mansfield or Chesterfield, or any address within a 15 mile radius of our premises by two members of staff at any time of the day or night, care of the deceased on our premises for up to 21 days, preparation of deceased, including embalming if requested, and provision of viewing facilities if appropriate.
- Provision of our Motor Hearse (or other suitable vehicle to lead the cortege and transport flowers and staff if an alternative hearse has been arranged from a Third Party), a Funeral Director and up to four Funeral Staff on the day of the Funeral. Your choice of starting point and route for the funeral procession (maximum of 30 miles & 2 ½ hours).
- Assistance with Music, Webcasts and Visual Tributes if required.
- Full donations handling service, including receiving, listing and forwarding of donations and an online donations page if required.
- Placing details of the funeral on our website and placing of newspapers notices if required.

Other charges for our services include:

- Limousines, each (up to 7 seats)
- Provision of additional staff on funerals and/or transfers into our care, when required to maintain safe working practices or when more than one transfer of the deceased is required.
- Please see final page of this brochure for a list of more of our additional services

• Funerals taking place outside of normal working hours – dependent on staffing needs

Third Party Fees - Your written estimate will include the fees that are payable to Third Parties, such as the Crematorium, Cemetery or Churchyard and Ministers and Celebrants, along with charges for items such as Alternative Funeral Vehicles and Newspaper Notices. Our Lower Cost Funeral Options brochure details some of these charges, but as there are so many variations it is not practical to try and list them fully. These charges are quoted at the costs known to us at the time of making the funeral arrangements. Any subsequent adjustment to these charges by the third parties involved is beyond our control and will be reflected on the final account. We request the payment of these Third Party fees prior to the funeral.

Coffin Selection

We know that every detail matters when arranging a loved one's funeral, and that includes the choice of the coffin. We provide a wide variety of choices to suit all preferences and budgets, from simple and understated designs to more elaborate and ornate options.

A truly Bespoke choice

The Veneered and Solid Timber coffins shown here are custom made for the deceased and delivered to us from our local manufacturers a few miles away. Within each style of coffin there are numerous options for you to choose from – veneered, solid timber or painted, custom end panels, your choice of interior and of either silver or brass effect handles. Your funeral arranger will go through the Coffin order form with you to ensure that the coffin is exactly as you want it.

Construction of the Coffin

Many of the designs shown in this brochure can be created in either Veneered or Solid Timber, and the cost of both options is shown on each page.

We are often asked about the differences between the two options. With a solid timber coffin, the lid, sides and ends of the coffin are made from single pieces of wood, providing a sense of natural beauty and warmth that cannot be replicated with veneer. In addition, the wood grain of a solid timber coffin is often more prominent and distinctive, as is often the case when comparing a piece of solid wood furniture with a veneered one.



Solid Timber was for a long time the traditional choice for burial as it was considered more durable and longer-lasting. This is a personal choice — veneered, woven or cardboard coffins are all suitable for burial. Solid timber coffins are also suitable for cremation for those who prefer the craftsmanship and sturdiness of a solid timber coffin. One of the visible differences between a veneered and a solid timber coffin is how the panels are jointed. The close-up here shows this butt jointing and also the distinctive woodgrain of a solid oak coffin.

The handles shown in the photographs in this brochure are just one of a range of styles available to you. The handles in our range are available in either Silver effect or Brass effect. For cremation, we use plastic handles which conform to cremation regulations. If the funeral is to be a burial, we recommend the use of metal handles to give added strength.

The Interior of the Coffin

We offer a range of interior options for our coffins. If the deceased is being dressed in their own clothes, you can choose from a variety of linings to match your loved one's style and preferences, including elegant satin, simple taffeta or natural unbleached cotton. The coffins in our woven range are supplied with an unbleached cotton interior.

Alternatively, we provide a selection of dressing gowns to choose from, which come with either a matching or contrasting lining or pillow depending on the design of the gown. Please see the options available at the end of this brochure.

Forever Hearts - A lasting memento

Whether or not you choose to have a custom engraving on the coffin you can order one or more engraved hearts for family and friends to keep as a lasting memento of their loved one. Each face can contain one image or up to 50 characters of text. These can be ordered either at the same time as the coffin is ordered or at a later date.




